The Daly College of Business Management (DCBM) team comprising of Ram Sharma, Tanisha Agrawal and Asmi Patodi bagged the most sought for trophy, and cash prize worth Rs 11,000 at Indore Management Association (IMA)'s QFL Competition which is one of the most revered competitions in the city of Indore.

Principal DCBM, Dr Sonal Sisodia said that this year, teams from the most coveted institutions of Indore participated in this engaging and cut-throat contest. The theme for the 22nd QFL was ReInvent, Evolve and Lead. It poses a simple question with complex answers to the brightest minds of the nation. This year's theme revolved around intriguing the young participants to come up with a strategy which businesses could incorporate in their missions, having seen a tremendous stagnation and crumbling post-Covid.

She further added that the winning team will be felicitated in the presence of esteemed dignitaries in the IMA Management Conclave, which is to take place earlier next year.

The idea presented by the team was a Nuclear Desalination Framework, with the notion to solve our nation's water stress problem. This idea stood out from normal desalination plant ideas because it paid heed to using nuclear energy, instead of using the country's fossil fuels, which are turning exiguous every passing moment. The participants presented how India could tap its underutilised resources, specifically the backwaters of the state of Kerala to install a nuclear desalination plant, which in turn would cater to the water needs of the entire nation.

The idea was highly lauded by the panel, and the students were applauded for their impeccable research and presentation skills.
